A Anti-Masking: The KX15DTAM uses the patented Anti-Masking technology to detect when both PIR and Microwave technologies are Masked. The detector is able to detect aluminium foil, spray and any object position on or in front of the detector with the purpose of obstructing the field of view of the PIR or MW sensors.

A1 The Mask is adjustable between 0 to 1M.

A2 If the Masking area is entered the Blue LED starts flashing to show that the area has been compromised. If the obstacle is removed after 30 seconds the detector will reset to normal. If the obstacle still remains after 1 minute, the MASK and ALARM relay will open and the Green and Orange LEDs will be permanently activated. To reset the detector, the obstacle must be removed and a walk test must be done.

B Blocking: This feature is to detect a partial obstruction of the PIR up to 15m when the panel is disarmed. When blocking is detected the alarm relay will open and the GREEN and ORANGE LEDs will be activated. To reset the blocking, the KX15DTAM must be walk tested so that the PIR and MW sensors are activated.

B1 Blocking Enabled/Disabled: To enable the feature, switch 6 must be OFF and the RI input should be connected to an output on the control panel which gives 0V when DISARMED and removes 0V when ARMED.

C KX15DTAM is supplied with the following:

KXBRACKETW (Wall Bracket), KXBRACKETC (Ceiling Bracket) and K-TAMPER (Back tamper)

E NOTE: When the 2 optional lenses are used the Microwave range remains at 15m.

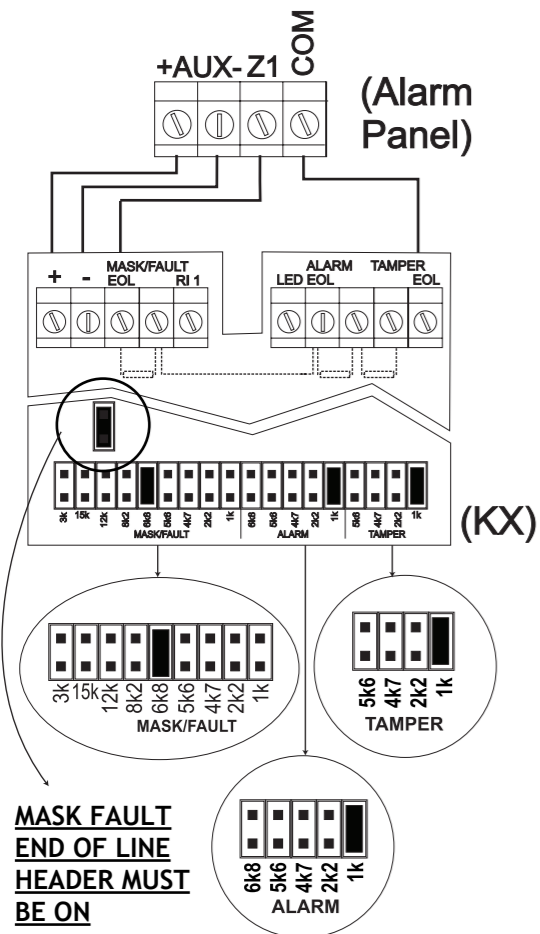


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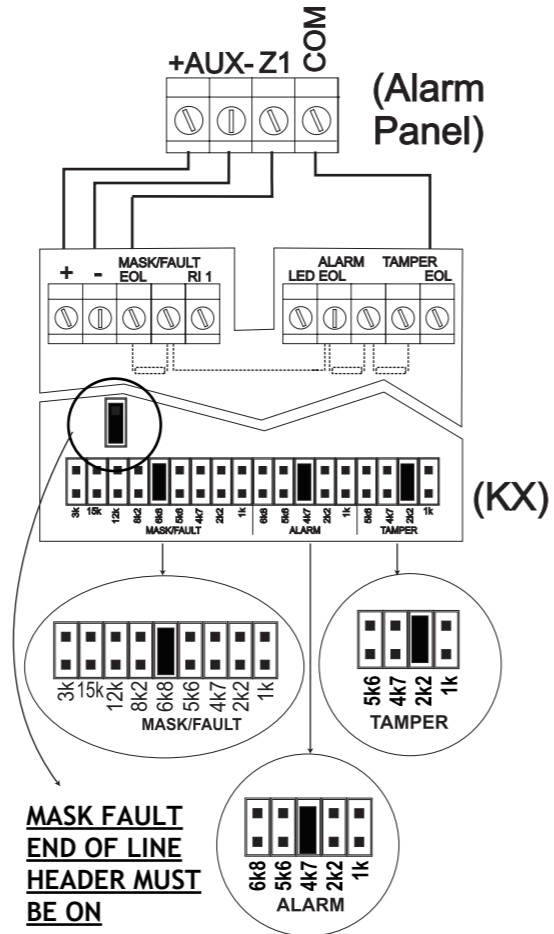


Grade 3 DEOL Connections: Connecting all three technologies to one input

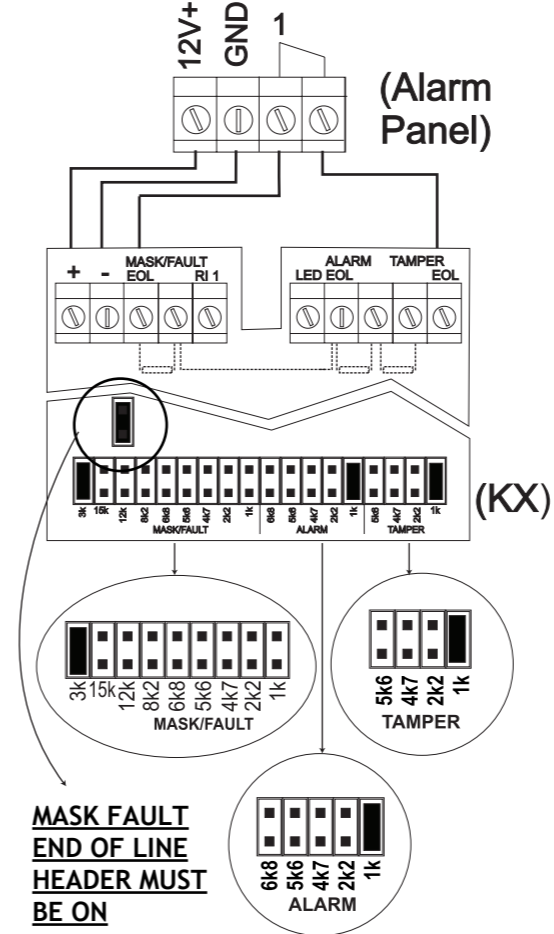

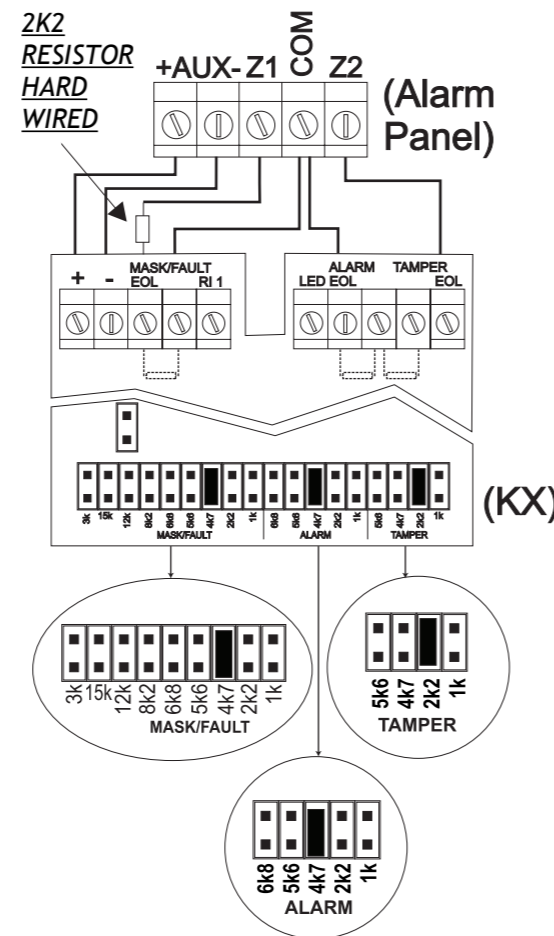


Conventional DEOL Connections: Connecting the PIR/Microwave to one input and the Anti-Masking to a separate input

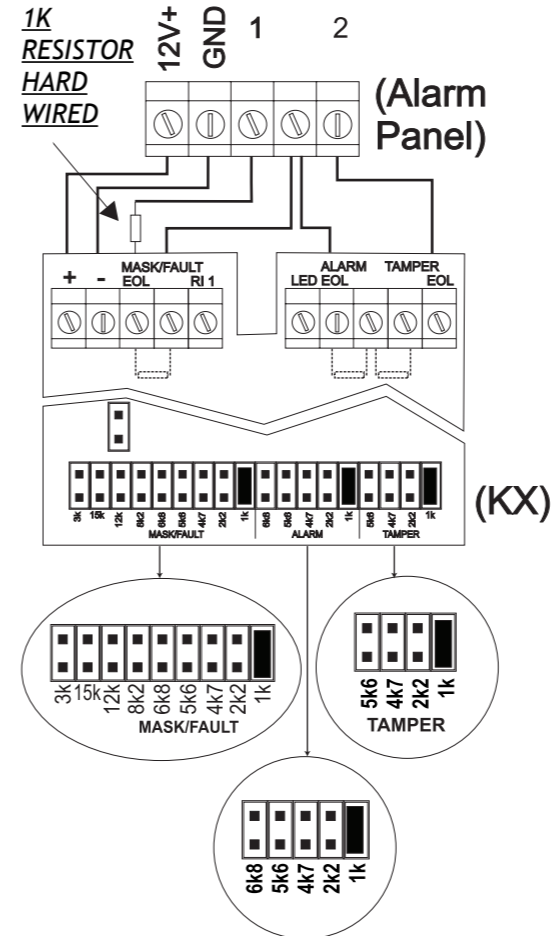
